ANNUAL REPORT.

IN order to promote good fellowship among Old Boys and to maintain their interest in the work of the School, it was decided, at the beginning of the year, to revive the Old Boys' Association. A meeting was held in March, and rules for a new constitution were drawn up.

The Association has had a good start. It has now a membership of 84, which must be considered as satisfactory in view of the difficulty of getting into touch with Old Boys. The Committee is elected with due regard to a territorial representation, so that at least one Old Boy in the area shall be in close touch with the Association.

Two well-attended General Meetings have been held, the one in March preceded by a Past v. Present Football Match; the other in July by a Cricket Match. In each case the meeting concluded with a most enjoyable Entertainment. A large number of Old Boys attended the School Sports on July 15th, and there was a good entry for the Old Boys' events.

General Meetings will usually be held on the last Saturday of the School Term. The Entertainment Sub-Committee is hoping to make arrangements for social functions other than on the days of General Meetings.

All Old Boys who are members are urged to make special personal efforts to see that all past members of the School become members, and so make the Association a real live one. The annual subscription of five shillings includes copies of the School Magazine, which now makes a special feature of Old Boys' news.
